



NAME OF SCHOOL

Fuzhou Concord College of Sino-Canada is a pre K-12 school operated by AKD International. The school currently has students enrolled up to grade 10 with the expectation of adding grades 11 and 12.

New Brunswick has been partnering with AKD since 1997 to offer a New Brunswick education to students in China. Fuzhou Concord College of Sino-Canada is one of the 15 schools operated by AKD in China through its partnership with New Brunswick.

In addition to the Chinese curriculum offered from pre K to grade 12, Fuzhou school offers the New Brunswick curriculum from grades 10 to 12 allowing students to earn a dual diploma. The school is comprised of students from age two through grade 10. Current enrolment is 40 students in kindergarten and 222 students in grades 1 – 10. In addition to the New Brunswick curriculum, Pre- Advanced Placement classes are offered. It is also a Round Square school. Founded in 1966, Round Square is a global network of innovative schools in 50 countries on six continents that share a passion for experiential learning and character education. The Round Square approach is built around six IDEALS of learning: internationalism, democracy, environmentalism, adventure leadership and service.

Facilities include a virtual reality room; dance studio; computer room and a recording studio as well as a gymnasium that is currently under construction.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Currently, teachers are being housed in the student dormitories while construction is being completed on the teacher accommodations. Later this year, staff will move into their apartments which will be in a separate building on campus.

CITY

Fuzhou is located in south China across the strait from Taiwan. It is famous for its sea views, mountains and historical sites. As the capital and one of the largest cities in Fujian Province, Fuzhou is also known as the “city of banyans”, because of the numerous Banyan trees planted there.

Fuzhou is an ideal tourist destination with mild weather and graceful natural scenery. It features spectacular forest parks, unique gardens, historic temples, ancient-style architecture and old streets.

CLIMATE

Fuzhou, bordering the East China Sea, has a warm and humid sub-tropical monsoon **climate** with abundant rainfall. The weather in **Fuzhou** is mild and the annual average temperature is about 19.6 C (67.28 F). Weather in spring is often rainy.
