## WOODSTOCK COMMUNITY

Woodstock is a town in Carleton County, New Brunswick, Canada on the Saint John River, 103 km upriver from Fredericton at the mouth of the Meduxnekeag River. It is near the Canada–United States border and Houlton, Maine and the intersection of Interstate 95 and the Trans-Canada Highway making it a transportation hub. It is also a service centre for the potato industry and for more than 26,000 people in the nearby communities of Hartland, Florenceville-Bristol, Centreville and Bath. Carleton County is the home of international headquarters of McCain Foods which employs people from around the world. Woodstock has recently added a large Civic Centre called the Ayr Motor Centre that the community enjoys for many sports including hockey, skating, indoor soccer, zumba, pickle ball and swimming. It also has a gym and a free indoor walking track. The New Brunswick Community College has a campus downtown Woodstock offering post-secondary programs in the areas of Business, Health, IT, Social Sciences and Trades.
