- Know how to incorporate choice and voice into classroom plans to promote student advocacy and engagement.
- Understand how to select appropriate assessment measures that align with learning outcomes.
- Understand how to provide descriptive feedback (peer and teacher).
- Be able to analyze and report assessment results AND how we can adjust instruction/learning as needed.
