



Post-Secondary Pathways for Students Graduating with a New Brunswick High School Diploma through AEI

Students who graduate with a New Brunswick high school diploma through Atlantic Education International (AEI) may be eligible for reduced tuition at partner universities across Atlantic Canada.

These pathways support students as they continue their education through strong university partnerships and meaningful financial support. Eligible students include those studying in New Brunswick and at accredited AEI offshore schools.

Institution	AEI Tuition Rate	Estimated Savings
St. Thomas University	Domestic tuition	Up to ~\$45,000
Mount Allison University	Domestic rate first 2 years	~\$20,000
Acadia University	Reduced AEI rate	~\$10,000 / year
Saint Mary's University	\$1,000 reduction / course	Varies

Additional Support

Eligible students can also apply for the Welcome to New Brunswick Bursary of up to \$1,250, as well as university scholarships like academic entrance, athletic, leadership, or community involvement awards.
